- Registered for parking via the Public Safety website (if your student intends to commute to campus or will be living on-campus and meets the requisites to obtain a parking pass).
- Submitted immunization records to UNC Asheville's Health & Counseling staff (this may have been completed before attending **embark** or during this morning's check-in session). If your student did not have the opportunity to check-in with representatives from Health and Counseling about his/her immunization records earlier today, has questions regarding the Student Health Insurance requirement, or needs to establish a continuity of care plan, your student can visit with staff from our Health and Counseling Office to address any of these needs in Lipinsky Lobby.
- Advisors will be available in the OneStop Office, which is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor of Ramsey Library to answer any final questions your student may have about the curriculum or fall 2017 course registration.
- The Financial Aid Office is located on the second floor in Brown Hall (adjacent to the Admissions Office).
- The Student Accounts Office is located on the bottom floor of Ramsey Library (inside the OneStop Office).
